Who can join the LWV?

All citizens -- women and men -- who are 18 or older may become members. Student members may join prior to age 18, and will be granted full membership (with voting privileges) when they turn 18. Joining the Montgomery County LWV automatically confers membership in the Indiana LWV and the national LWV.
